naveg ar (por Internet)	belongs to the –AR group of verbs
cant ar	belongs to the –AR group of verbs
bail ar	belongs to the –AR group of verbs
sac ar (fotos)	belongs to the –AR group of verbs
mand ar (mensajes)	belongs to the –AR group of verbs
toc ar (la guitarra)	belongs to the –AR group of verbs

The form of the verb which ends in **–AR** is known as the **infinitive** and always means **TO** _____

You have met this verb form in the construction:

me gusta **navegar** por Internet etc
I like **TO SURF** the Internet
