The form of the verb which ends in **-IR**
is known as the **infinitive** and always
means **TO** _____

me gusta **escribir mensajes**
I like **TO WRITE** messages

I	yo	o	same as -AR and -ER verbs!
you (singular)	tú	es	same as -ER verbs!
he/she/it	él/ella	e	same as -ER verbs!
we	nosotros	imos	
you (plural)	vosotros	ís	
they	ellos/ellas	en	same as -ER verbs!
